This report describes the activities of MFESTS from January 1, 2011 thru December 31, 2012.

The mission of MFESTS is to provide service to our member societies, to provide service to the citizens of the state of Minnesota, and to provide service to professionals in engineering related careers. This was accomplished through communication at meetings and through the MFESTS website, granting awards for professional achievement, and partnering with other organizations for education outreach and joint cooperative events.

2012 Notable Highlights:

Youth - Outreach

- Judged and awarded the 8th annual MFESTS "Engineering Excellence" Special Award at the
 Minnesota Future Cities Regional Competition held Saturday, January 14, 2012 at the University
 of Minnesota EE/CSCI building. This year's award went to Dakota Hills Middle School (Eagan,
 MN) for their city of Plexia. Very nice Gift bags were provided to the team members, and
 MFESTS again contributed financially as a non-profit Bronze Sponsor. Judges were; Cory
 Grabinger (HEC), Mark Feitel (INCOSE), Harry Schroeder (SME) and his college son and Kurt
 Nordstrom (ISA).
- MFESTS again had a large participation at the annual E-week TechFest event held on Saturday, February 25th, 2012 at The Works Museum's new location in Bloomington, MN. Over 25 MFESTS volunteers and volunteers from numerous other organizations supported the event with 1,500 people attending.
- MFESTS provided 2 Silent Auction baskets at the E-week annual Awards & Recognition Banquet held Friday, February 24, 2012 at the Nicollet Island Pavilion. Proceeds benefit Youth Tech Programs, and the donations helped surpass the fundraising goal by a large margin.
