# 2014 Annual Report

This report describes the activities of MFESTS from January 1, 2014 thru December 31, 2014. The mission of MFESTS is to provide service to our member societies, to provide service to the citizens of the state of Minnesota, and to provide service to professionals in engineering related careers. This was accomplished through communication at meetings and through the MFESTS website awards for professional achievement, and partnering with other organizations for education outreach and joint cooperative events.

#### Youth - Outreach

- Judged and awarded the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual MFESTS "Engineering Excellence" Special Award at the Minnesota Future Cities Regional Competition held Saturday, January 18th, 2013 at the University of Minnesota Science Teaching & Student Services (STSS) Building. The award is given to the team that best integrates the use of many different engineering disciplines, uses creative and practical engineering solutions and plans for future growth. This year's award went to Friendly Hills Middle School, Mendota Heights for their city of Mahogany City. Very nice gift bags were provided to the team and MFESTS again financially contributed as a non-profit Bronze Sponsor. Kurt Nordstrom (ISA/INCOSE/MFESTS) was a judge at the event along with others from MFESTS.
- MFESTS again had a large participation at the 11th Annual E-week TechFest event held on Saturday, February 22<sup>d</sup>, 2014 at the Works Museum in Bloomington, MN. Over 25 MFESTS volunteers and numerous organizations supported the event of 1,300+ attendees.
- Supported MN FIRST LEGO League for grades 4-9 through refereeing competition in January, November and December of 2014. Minnesota state competition is in February.
- Made financial contributions to the Math Counts Program

### **Cross-Society Joint Interaction**

- The 4<sup>nd</sup> Annual MFESTS Society Summer Program Planners meeting was held on Wednesday, October 15, 2014 in the Eden Prairie Library's Large Meeting Room. Over 36 people attended and most of the MFESTS societies were represented at the meeting. The meeting started with a snowball networking/introduction exercise that was fun (for a networking opportunity). Joe Meyers gave a very professional presentation "Building an Organization One Brick at a Time." Meeting survey results indicated that the meeting exceeded expectations and that there is an interest in exploring the membership Theme in greater depth in a future meeting.
